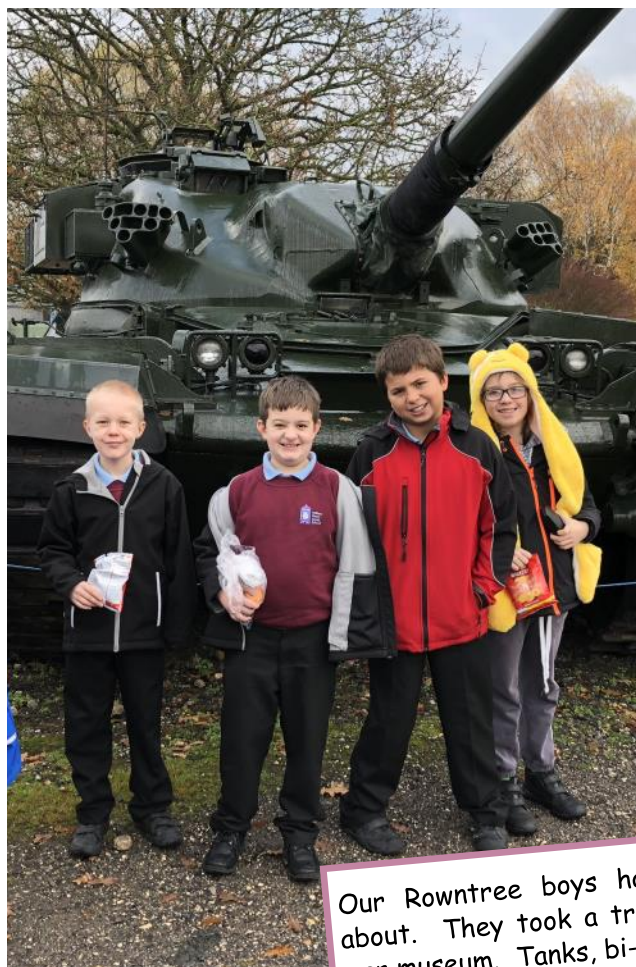

Design Technology has featured heavily for our Adams boys. They have designed, constructed, refined and polished their own storage boxes as part of their ongoing coursework.



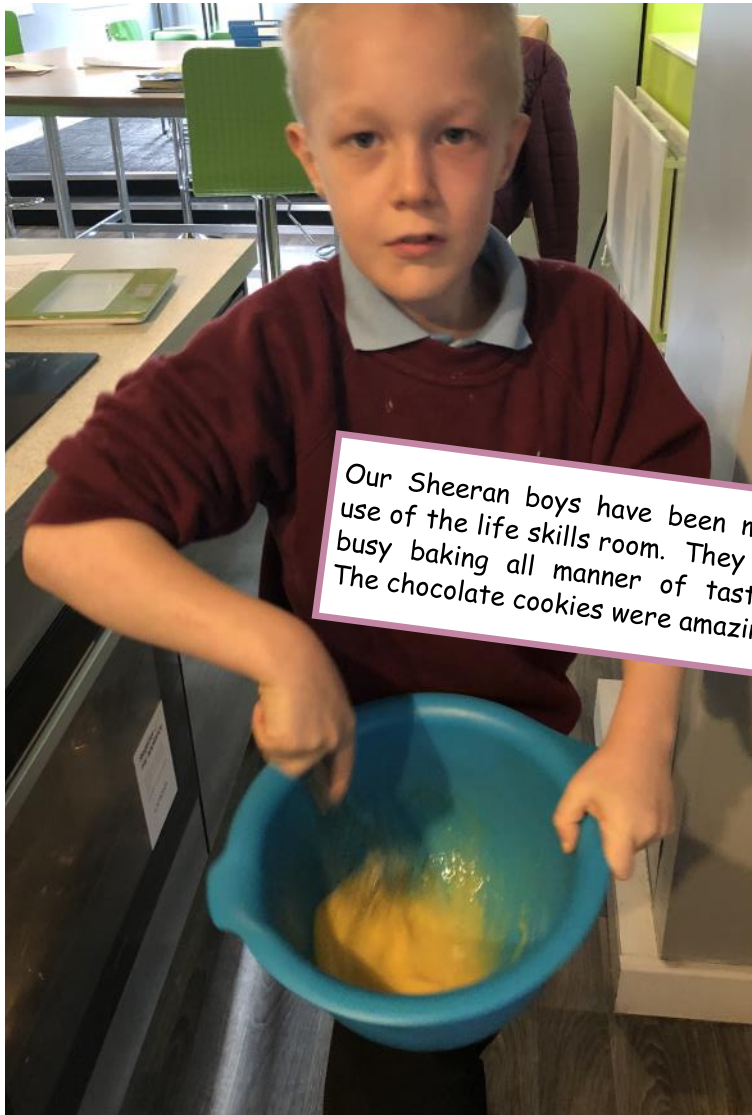

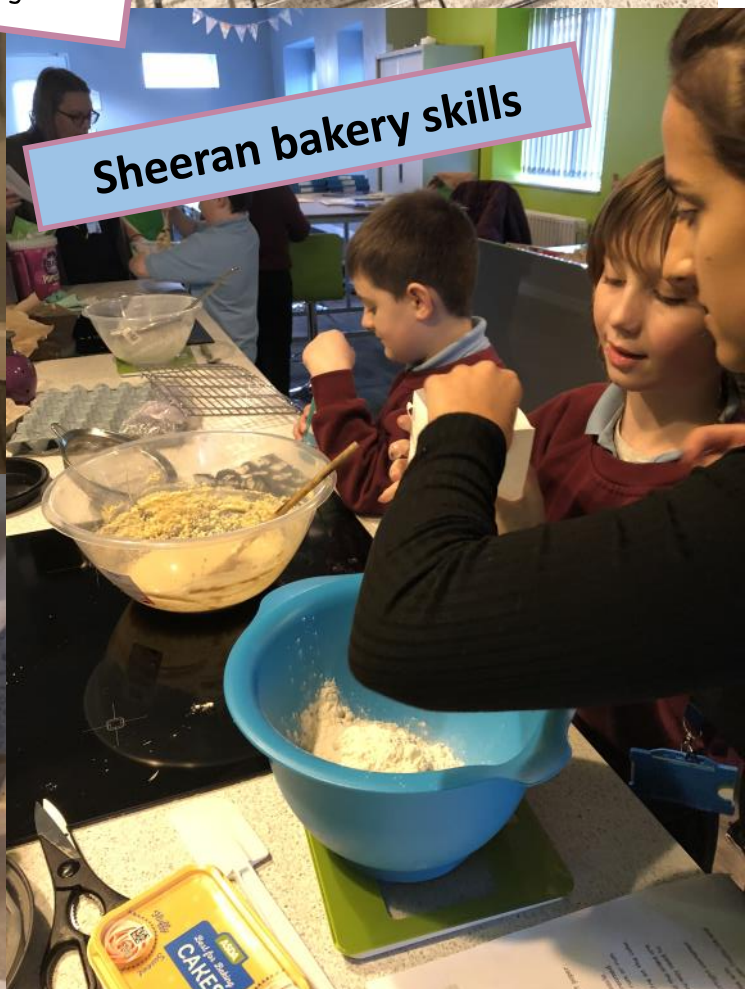
