# Thematic Studies – including History and Geography



## **History** Maafa

This project looks at Africa past and present and the development of the slave trade. It explores Britain's role in the transatlantic slave trade, the causes and consequences of the European colonisation of Africa.

## **Geography -** Our Changing World

This looks at features of the Earth, time zones and lines of latitude and longitude to pinpoint places on a map. We will look at map scales, grid references, contour lines and map symbols. We will learn about climate change and global trade.
